The Preliminary Competition Schedule of the ISSF World Championship is attached to this General Information. The Final Competition Schedule (including Training Schedule) will be distributed after the Final Entry Deadline (30 days before the Official Arrival Day).
The latest Schedule updates will be provided at the Technical Meeting.

3. Rules and Regulations

The ISSF World Championship will be conducted according to the actual ISSF Rules and Regulations. Detailed information is available on the ISSF website www.issf-sports.org.

ISSF Juries (Competition Jury, RTS Jury, and Equipment Control Jury) will be designated by the ISSF to supervise the ISSF World Championship. Qualified Range Officers / Referees holding applicable ISSF licenses will conduct the competitions.

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Rifle / Pistol Equipment

Equipment Control will be conducted according to ISSF Rules using approved, calibrated instruments. Pre-competition testing is not mandatory; however, athletes are responsible for competing with legal equipment and clothing. All athletes are urged to submit any doubtful equipment and clothing to Equipment Control for checking before the competition. All athletes are subject to being selected for random post-competition testing and will be disqualified if their equipment or clothing is not legal according to ISSF Rules.

All pistols must be registered in ISSF database. Pistols that have not been registered or recorded must be checked for compliance with ISSF Rules and registered to the athlete.

Rifle Clothing

All Rifle athletes must have ISSF Seals with serial numbers on their jackets, trousers and shoes. Any jackets or trousers that do not have ISSF Seals must be submitted to Equipment Control for inspection and the affixing of a seal before the athlete's first competition. All existing ISSF seals and Equipment Control cards / certificates issued to jackets and trousers will cease to be valid as from 1st January 2026. All those items of clothing must be submitted to Equipment Control for testing at the first opportunity when attending an ISSF Championship so that new seals and Equipment Control cards / certificates will be issued. Athletes that wish to replace a registered jacket or trousers with a new clothing item must bring that item to Equipment Control for inspection and a new seal. Previous seals will then be cancelled. Rifle athletes can have only one active jacket and trousers at any time.

Rifle Clothing Post-Competition Stiffness Testing

If one panel of a rifle jacket or trousers tests 2.9 or lower, the stiffness device must be recalibrated, and the panel must be retested. If it fails again, but all other panels pass, the athlete will not be disqualified and further procedures will take place. If two or more panels fail, the athlete must be disqualified.

Air or CO₂ Cylinders

It is the athlete's responsibility to ensure that any air or CO₂ cylinder is still within its validity date. This may be checked by Equipment Control. Please be aware that in some countries it is a federal offence to use outdated compressed gas cylinders.

Shotgun Equipment

All Skeet athletes must have an ISSF seal with serial number on their Skeet marker tapes. Any shooting vests that do not have an ISSF seal on the Skeet marker tape must be submitted to Equipment Control for inspection and the affixing of a seal before the competition.

Equipment Control will be conducted according to ISSF Rules using approved, calibrated instruments. Pre-competition testing is not mandatory. However, athletes are responsible for competing with legal equipment and clothing. All athletes are urged to submit any doubtful equipment and clothing to Equipment Control or the Shotgun Jury for checking before the competition. All athletes are subject to being selected for random testing during the competition. Athletes found to be in violation of the rules for Shotguns or Skeet marker tapes will be disqualified.

Buttstock Height (for Skeet only)

The height of the buttstock (either adjustable or "Monte Carlo" type) measured from the highest point of the cheek rest to the lowest point of the butt plate toe must not exceed 170mm (17cm). Any butt plate



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toe vertical extension which is not an integral part of the buttstock and simply intended to increase its height, is not permitted.

Cartridge Control

During Qualification, athletes whose cartridges are to be tested are selected by a computer draw. Between 10% and 18% of the athletes participating in an event will be selected for cartridge testing. Two (2) plus four (4) cartridges will be selected from each athlete and placed in separate labeled envelopes. The two (2) cartridges must be tested first. If both cartridges weigh 24.50 g or less, no further action will be taken. If one (1) or both cartridges weigh more than 24.50g, then the four (4) cartridges in the second envelope must be tested. If the average of the six (6) cartridges weighs more than 24.50 g, then the athlete must be disqualified (DSQ).

During Final, all eight (8) finalists must be tested using the same procedure. The Finalists or their Coaches/Officials must bring, as early as possible, but not later than 30 minutes before the scheduled start of the Final (Reporting Time), all the cartridges that will be used during the Final and place them in separate Cartridge Control Boxes on the Finals field of play. The Equipment Control Jury will take the necessary samples from the boxes. The boxes must be left under the supervision of a Shotgun Jury Member. Once cartridges are placed in the box, only the Equipment Control Jury or the Finalist can remove cartridges from the box. If additional cartridges are brought to a Finalist during Finals, samples from those cartridges must also be selected for testing. All cartridge controls must be completed before the start of the Presentation of the Finalists. Any disqualified (DSQ) athlete will not be allowed to participate in the Final (There will be no elimination for 8th place; the first elimination will be for 7th place).

Colored Wads

Any ejecta (Wad), except for the shot or powder, must be transparent or translucent. The shot must not have any color added. No other element can be added that could be distinguished as a Hit Target.

Equipment Control

Equipment Control will be open to athletes according to the Competition Schedule.

4. Participation

Individual Events

ISSF Member Federations can enter a maximum of three (3) athletes per individual event who may participate as one (1) team in team event.

Team Events

ISSF Member Federations can enter a maximum of one (1) team per team event, consisting of three (3) athletes from the respective individual event. The declaration of the team members must be done during the Online Registration process.

Mixed Team Events

ISSF Member Federations can enter a maximum of two (2) teams per mixed team event, consisting of one (1) male and one (1) female athlete.

Maximum Entry / Range Capacity

The maximum number of starts per event is the number of athlete / mixed team entries that can be accepted for each event. Range capacity is determined by the available shooting time and the number of available firing points / ranges.

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If the maximum number of starts is reached during the Final Entry process, a "waiting list" for that event(s) will be established. If cancellations are subsequently received, entries from the waiting list will be entered on a first come, first served basis.

ISSF and Organizing Committee will cooperate to determine if additional entries from the waiting list can be accommodated.

ISSF ID Number

All athletes must sign an "Athlete's Declaration" and have an official ISSF ID number issued before participation in the ISSF World Championship.

Athletes without ISSF ID number will not be allowed to participate. ISSF ID numbers can be obtained from the ISSF Headquarters by using the official application form.

Minimum Participation Requirements

The minimum participation requirements for official ISSF World Championship events, so with official Championship medals and the opportunity to set official ISSF World Records, are as following:

- Individual Events 15 Athletes
- Team Events 5 Teams
- Mixed Team Events 10 Mixed Teams

If an event does not reach the minimum requirement at the Final Entry Deadline, the federations with entries in this event will be notified.

If an event does not reach the minimum requirement at the Late Entry Deadline, it will be declared an "International Championship of Qatar".

LA28 Quota Places

Quota Places for the LA28 Olympic Games will be awarded according to the Qualification System published on the IOC website <https://www.olympics.com/ioc/documents/olympic-games/los-angeles-2028-olympic-games>.

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5. Registration Process

Please complete the attached Registration Forms (Annex 1 – 6) and return them by the established deadlines (see also: “Summary of Deadlines”).

Preliminary and Final Entries for Athletes and Officials must be done directly online by using the ISSF Online Registration System only. There are no separate Registration Forms available, any entries received by email will not be accepted.

Preliminary Entries

ISSF Member Federations must submit their Preliminary Entries by using the ISSF Online Registration System at <https://shootingsportscld.com>.
The Preliminary Entry Deadline is **1 AUG 2026**.

Final Entries

ISSF Member Federations must submit their Final Entries by using the ISSF Online Registration System at <https://shootingsportscld.com>.
The **Final Entry Deadline** (30 days before the Official Arrival Day) is **2 OCT 2026**.

Important Note: To participate in the Team Events, the teams – consisting of three (3) athletes from the respective individual event – must be declared in the Online Registration → “Teams”.

Late Entries

If the maximum number of athlete entries has not been reached, late entries will only be accepted until the **Late Entry Deadline** (3 days before the Official Arrival Day) which is **28 OCT 2026**.

Important Note: Until the 3 days Late Entry Deadline, the change of names / athletes within an event in the Final Entries are possible without restrictions and additional fees.
Any additional entries received after the Late Entry Deadline, from **29 OCT 2026** onwards, may not participate.

Entry Confirmation upon arrival

All Team Leaders of participating ISSF Member Federations must report to the Organizing Committee Entries Official and confirm their Final Entries. The confirmation must be completed before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training.

Entry Changes after the Late Entry Deadline

From **29 OCT 2026** onwards, only the replacement of a registered athlete by another already registered athlete (in another event) is permitted and can be made only before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training for that specific event.

Cancellation

Any ISSF Member Federation that reduces the number of athletes and / or officials after the Final Entry Deadline (**2 OCT 2026**) must pay all applicable entry fees and hotel room cancellation costs according to the number of athletes and officials entries originally received. If the applicable fees and costs are not paid, no member of that federation may participate.

Entry Fees

The entry fees include all charges for registration, local transportation between shooting range and official hotels and doping control.

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The entry fees include one (1) round of Pre-Event Training for Shotgun.
They DO NOT include additional costs for Pre-Event and Unofficial Training for Shotgun.

Payment of Entry Fees

All payments must be by **credit/debit card or bank transfer only. Cash will NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

Upon request, an invoice can be sent for payments through bank transfer. All bank expenses must be borne by the participating federations.

Accreditation Process

All persons involved in the ISSF World Championship (Athletes, Team Officials, ISSF Officials, OC Officials, Media Persons, ...) must have accreditations that clearly identify the accreditation holder (with photograph, family name and first name, country and function) in order to use the local transportation and to enter controlled areas on the shooting range.

Accreditations (for persons registered before the Late Entry Deadline) will be prepared in advance by the ISSF and Organizing Committee. During the online registration process, the ISSF Member Federations can upload pictures of their athletes and officials to be displayed on the accreditations.

There will be no possibility to take photos for accreditations on the shooting range.

Accreditations and BIB Numbers will be distributed by the Organizing Committee after payment of the entry fees.

6. Shooting Range

The ISSF World Championship will take place at the "Lusail Shooting Complex" on the outskirts of the city of Doha, Qatar.

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Rifle/Pistol

The shooting range is equipped as follows:

Range	Description
10m range	80 firing points, electronic targets, SIUS AG
25m range	60 firing points (12 groups), electronic targets, SIUS AG
50m range	80 firing points, electronic targets, SIUS AG
Finals hall	10 firing points, electronic targets, SIUS AG

The firing direction of the 25m and 50m range is north.

Rifle/Pistol ranges will be open for Unofficial Training from 21 OCT 2026.

Shotgun

The shooting range has 6 combined ranges for Trap/Skeet.

The shooting range is equipped with Laporte machines and Elettronica Progetti acoustic release system.

All ranges are equipped with Elettronica Progetti electronic scoreboards.

The firing direction of the shooting range is north / north-east.

The targets used for the ISSF World Championship are eco-friendly from Laporte, standard orange for the Qualification and flash orange for the Finals.

Shotgun ranges will be open for Unofficial Training from 1 NOV 2026.

7. Immigration and Customs Requirements

Entry Visa

Nationals of more than 100 countries are now eligible for Visa-free entry upon arrival in Qatar.

Detailed information regarding visas and formalities for entry into Qatar can be found on the Ministry of Interior website: <https://portal.moi.gov.qa/qatarvisas/>

The Organizing Committee will assist participants whose nationality needs prior arrangements for the Entry Visa.

Visa requests can be processed only if accompanied by the following documents:

1. **A clear scanned copy of the data page of the passport** including the machine-readable zone (MZR) at the bottom, not exceeding 2MB.
2. **A colored passport size photograph** (white background) for each applicant, not exceeding 2MB.
3. Contact number and email address of the applicant or federation
4. **All documents must be sent in JPG format (not PDF).**

The Visa Support Form (Annex 5) and the required documents must be sent within and not later than **2 OCT 2026**.

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Custom Formalities, Import of Firearms

A temporary import license will be issued to all participants by the Qatar Ministry of Interior; the Organizing Committee will email the permit to the federation prior to the arrival date. Kindly send to the Organizing Committee the Firearm and Ammunition Form (Annex 6) not later than **2 OCT 2026**.

Upon arrival, the Organizing Committee airport officers will meet participants at the baggage collection belt and will assist them in dispatching the Police and Customs formalities of firearms.

The **Qatari law strictly prohibits taking firearms and ammunition to the hotel**. Upon arrival, firearms and ammunition will be transported by our officers from the airport to the Shooting Complex and back to the airport at the end of the competition.

Useful information on the carriage of Firearms on International Flights

As a rule, before issuing any flight ticket the travel agency appointed to book the flights should make sure that both firearms and the ammunition are accepted on board the aircraft till the final destination. The approval should appear in the electronic ticket (on the PNR Passengers Name Record) or on a separate message sent to the travel agency by the Airline Company.

The rules governing the carriage of firearms and ammunition are those of the carrier who owns the aircraft therefore, in case of flights made in code-sharing, the approval must come from both companies even if on the ticket the abbreviation of only one Company appears (i.e.: AF-BA-LH-QA, etc.).

Normally, the final decision to accept firearms and ammunition on board comes from the captain/Airline Company, but once you have the "OK" on your flight ticket, the Airline Company is responsible for having your firearms sent to destination.

In case of indirect flights, it is advisable to consider a connection of at least two hours.

Upon landing at the first airport, report to the information counter and make sure that your firearms have arrived and will be taken on board the connecting flight.

Still, in case of indirect flights, avoid booking them with two different Airline Companies as most of the time the firearms will be discharged and left at the first airport and the owners will have to collect them and make a new check-in, provided the local police authorities do not cause problems of licenses. That will probably cost extra security and boarding taxes and sometimes extra baggage fees. If passengers are not informed, they risk arriving at the final destination without knowing that their firearms have not been loaded on the connecting flight and are lying in the previous airport. In many countries even if in transit and the baggage is labeled till destination, the control of firearm is made at the first airport of arrival, and this is why it is advisable to keep the situation under control step by step.

All firearms and ammunition must be declared while making flight reservations and at check-in and follow the procedure reserved for these special articles. It is a big mistake to pack them into normal bags and dispatch them as normal baggage because in case of loss it will be very difficult to find the firearm in a short time and, last but not least, owners will be liable to heavy fines.

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Reservation must be made through the Organizing Committee and will be on a first come – first served basis.

The Final Hotel Reservation Form (Annex 2) and the Final Rooming List (Annex 3) must be submitted by **20 SEP 2026**. Please note that, due to the high number of events taking place in Doha during November, the deadline must be rigorously met in order to guarantee accommodation.

The Shooting Complex has a restaurant for buffet meals and kiosks for snacks and beverages.

9. Travel and Transportation

Travel – Arrival

Arrival in Qatar is through Hamad International Airport in Doha which offers excellent travel connections with the entire world. Qatar Airways has flights with more than 150 international destinations. Passengers flying Qatar Airways, carrying firearms and ammunition are required to complete the online request form through the following link:

Airport pick up – Transportation to the Official Hotels (and return for departure)

The airport pick-up service will be active and free of charge **from 1 to 14 NOV 2026**. Participants will be met at the ARRIVALS area near the Information Point by the Organizing Committee staff bearing a signboard with the logo of the championship.

In case of early arrival, the pick-up service can be arranged at a charge of 45 USD per person. Kindly note that **assistance at the airport for firearms will be granted free of charge regardless of the arrival date.**

The distance from the airport to West Bay area, where the hotels are located, is approximately 25 minutes. The distance to the shooting complex is approximately 45 minutes.

Local Transportation – Shuttle Service

The Shuttle Service between the official hotels and the shooting complex will be available from **1 NOV 2026**. The schedule will be published at the hotels' info desks and at the shooting complex info boards.

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10. Competition Related Procedures at the Shooting Range

Technical Meeting

The Technical Meeting for Rifle/Pistol will take place on 2 NOV 2026 in the Finals hall.

The Technical Meeting for Skeet will take place on 3 NOV 2026 at the Shotgun range.

The Technical Meeting for Trap will take place on 9 NOV 2026 at the Shotgun range.

Each participating ISSF Member Federation is kindly requested to have at least one representative present at the Technical Meeting to receive updated information regarding Final Competition and Training Schedules, draw procedures and other important issues related to the ISSF World Championship.

The time of the meetings will be confirmed after the Final Entry Deadline (see also: Final Competition Schedule).

Storage of Firearms and Ammunition

The **Qatari law strictly prohibits taking firearms and ammunition to the hotel**. Upon arrival, firearms and ammunition will be transported by the police officers from the airport to the shooting complex and back to the airport at the end of the competition.

Firearms and ammunition will be stored at the shotgun armoury and at the rifle & pistol armoury located near the respective ranges. The service, operating 24 hours, is free of charge.

Ammunition

The customs authorities will allow participating athletes to import all the necessary ammunition that will be used for the competition if the amount of ammunition is declared on the Firearm and Ammunition Form (Annex 6).
